
MEZZANINE LEVEL

CHILDREN'S LIBRARY

1.The Lantern: \$800,000



STREET LEVEL

1.Atrium: \$400,000

A glass structure running the length of the building that connects the historic library to the new expansion. The atrium will enable everyone who enters to view the stunning architectural features on the west exterior of the historic structure and build excitement to see the newly created space to the west. It is the focal point of the building complex in a highly trafficked area. The atrium will include gallery space for art and other displays while providing a beautiful connection to meld the old and the new and lead the way to the computer lab and the gorgeous gardens to the north.



2.Computer Lab: \$50,000

A cutting edge space designated to provide the public with high speed internet access on easy to use computers. This space is sure to be used regularly by library visitors, but will also be a place for many to learn how to navigate the electronic world with classes offered on the basics to more advanced software specific applications.

3.Main Floor Lobby: \$120,000

This comfortable, warm and inviting space will be the first stop and impression upon all those visiting the shild ers virg. This space houses an electron to all floor of the building, the stairs, and a comfortable waiting area that will be easily accessible.

4.Study Room: \$50,000

A public use study room in the historic library will allow for private, quiet study or as a meeting space for two to four people. This space will be an excellent area for shared collaboration on projects with technologies that will assist in the creative process.

5.Stairwell: \$100,000

A cascade of stairs will lead to other exciting areas, upstairs to the teen loft, or downstairs to the lobby of the conference room. The stairwell is a gateway to your next adventure and allows you to move about the library.

6.Elevator: \$200,000

A must have for a creation that will have so many levels. This elevator will be seen and used by everyone entering the building. Featuring a beautiful facace on an levels to we conce guests who are on their way to their next adventure.

CONFERENCE CENTER

1.Conference Room: \$700,000

A wonderful state of the art multi-functional space of 3,005 Square Feet - Enough room to house 300 in lecture style or seat 200 in a beautiful banquet setting. This is the perfect space for small conferences, engaging speakers, concerts, community-theater and so much more. The possibilities are endless. It will be a perfect community gathering space. The large room will have the flexibility to be separated into three smaller rooms with capacity of 65, 110, and 87 seats in a lecture setting. This beautiful space will open onto the lower garden patio, so the natural light will flood into the room. It will give participants a wonderful way to get fresh air and enjoy nature during their event.

3.Conference Center Lobby: \$120,000

This will be a perfect welcome to the new conference center. A space where one can comfortably wait to say hello to other attendees. It will be a warm, inviting space where attendees will enter and engage with one another in a relaxed setting.

4.Catering Kitchen: \$200,000

A first class kitchen will allow for food preparation to enhance every event offered in the conference center. This space will be full service and house only the best, most up to date equipment and appliances that will allow every function held at the center to be first class.

2.Stage: \$75,000

The stage is the focal point of the conference center. All eyes will be focused on this raised platform that will be outfitted with state-of-the-art lights and electronics.

GENEALOGY CENTER


1.Genealogy Room: \$200,000

Home to the genealogy and local history collection. This beautifully renovated space will be located in the lower level of the historic library and will include space for the existing and growing collection along with many archived materials. A comfortable, inviting and quiet research space with lots of room to work. It will house a large workroom where staff and volunteers will be scanning and digitizing historical documents - all while preserving these long held treasures of our past. The genealogy center will occupy 3,282 sq. ft. of prime space to house and build a collection that our local genealogists will utilize and attract year-round visitors.

2. Study Room 1 / Recording Studio:\$120.000

This room will serve as a recording studio for oral histories and other creative endeavors. It will house all the equipment necessary to record, edit and preserve oral histories of our area icons, community leaders and characters to get the true history of years gone by in this small community that is rich with heritage and stories. The equipment will allow recordings of stories and tales that will be documented and preserved for generations to

3.Study Room 2: \$50,000
